

1. INTRODUCTION

The Dhillon Marty Foundation (DMF) organized its seventh Annual Conference "State of the Community" in Paris, France on June 26th to the 29th, 2018. The conference was executed in partnership with CIDJ (Centre d'Information et de Documentation de la Jeunesse) at their center, and supported by UNESCO's MOST (Management of Social Transformations). The 7th Annual Conference entitled #ShareYourHumanity brought together participants to actively engage in various social practice art programs and intellectual discourse on contemporary global issues.

The conference aimed to design the path that our global society must take, in order to face the opportunities and challenges presented by the Digital Age. The program included panel discussions and art/cultural events, conducted in partnership with various educational and cultural institutions.

The conference operated in English and French.





2. HIGHLIGHTS – Pre-conference programs

a. Empreinte Civique

June 16-30 Various locations

The pre-conference programs were launched through the distribution of *Empreinte Civique*, a daily paper (newspaper-like flyers with latest news headlines and thought-provoking quotations for a daily topic) published across 15 countries, as part of the global exhibition. As a call to action, *Empreinte Civique* questions how our footprint — in its many forms — is influencing society in positive or negative ways. The initiative galvanized positive social change especially among the youth around the world, as much as with the conference participants in Paris.



In 2015, the world's governments have, under UN auspices, adopted the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. In contrast to the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), which guided the preceding 2000-15 period, this Agenda emphasises that development is needed not merely in the "developing" countries but for all human beings in all sectors of every society.

En 2015, les gouvernements du monde ont, sous les auspices des Nations Unies, adopté l'Agenda 2030 pour le Développement Durable. A l'inverse des Objectifs de Développement du Millénaire (ODM), qui guidaient la période antérieure de 2000-2015, cet Agenda insiste sur le fait que le développement n'est pas seulement nécessaire pour les pays « en voie de développement », mais pour tous les êtres humains dans tous les secteurs de la société.

No One Left Behind

Agenda 2030 understands such development not as aggregate economic growth but as full human development: the eradication of all serious deprivations and disadvantages. Alluding to the priority concern for the least advantaged in John Rawls's Theory of Justice, the chosen motto of Agenda 2030 is "Leave No One Behind." Its central commitments are formulated as a list of 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), substantiated by 169 more specific targets. These goals address poverty, food, water, sanitation, energy, health, education, employment, gender equality, income inequality within and among countries, emissions reduction, a clean and sustainable environment, peace, justice and international collaboration.



b. Street Art Performance: Live Painting on Mattress

Painting street art (symbolizing democracy and civic activism) on mattresses (symbolizing our closest personal space and a "safe place"), the live performance emphasized that individual and the community's well being go hand in hand, and the importance of creating such "safe place" for the democracy with all of our hands.

Throughout the conference, the back of the mattress collected the signatures of the participants, as their vow to take part in protection and nurturing of peace and democracy, as symbolized in the artwork by *lask*.

Japanese tea master *Soyu Mori* and his team introduced the history and philosophy behind tea ceremony: the spirit of being in harmony with all beings, hospitality and of sharing of the tea and time/space with others.



Garden exchange "Garden Share" took such reflections further and invited participants to plant flower seeds at the Dhillon Marty Foundation's urban farm at the event venue Verger du Gros Caillou, to express value of food and nature, and to remind participants that it is in the hands of each one of us to seed quality food, living and sustainable future for all elements of the earth.





d. Impromptu Music & Dance Performance "Social Movement"

Shakuhachi performance by *Hideo Sekino* invited participants to join in an impromptu dance performance, as a metaphor for individual citizens inspiring and inviting each other to achieve sustainable democracy.





e. Street Cleaning "Soji"

Participants joined in a street cleaning at Place de la République to mimic the common Japanese practice of cleaning of communal spaces, as a reminder that we are all responsible for communal resources.







f. Virtual Reality Exhibition "In Search of Humanity" & Pre-conference Cocktail Monday, June 25, 2018

Julie Walsh and Walsh Productions brought in "In Search of Humanity", an international survey exhibition of Virtual Reality (VR) art.

Participants joined in an interactive exhibition to examine "how artists using technology can actually heighten our humanity by creating empathy, wonder, and even relaxation for the global citizen". The pieces explored "themes of architecture and spirituality, migration and memory, meditation, the relationship of time, space and mathematics and the questioning of what makes social interactions real".
